Aeternum is a licensed residential treatment home occupying a single-family Craftsman house on a quiet residential street in Hillsboro, Oregon. Everything about the setting is intentional: a front porch, a kitchen island, a garden out back, and a small enough household that everyone knows everyone.

The setting

- Single-family Craftsman residence with a covered front porch
- Private and shared bedrooms, each personalized by the resident
- Common living room with a fireplace, bookshelves, and comfortable seating
- Large kitchen and one shared dining table
- Backyard with raised garden beds, patio, and mature trees
- Laundry, quiet spaces, and a secure medication room on site
- Quiet neighborhood with sidewalks, parks, and transit nearby

- Awake staff on site 24 hours a day, 7 days a week, including holidays
- Home Director responsible for daily operations and quality

- Support Coordinator leading person-centered planning
- Health and wellness coordination role for medications and appointments
- Daily living coaches for skills, cooking, budgeting, and transit
- Community connections role linking residents to work, school, and volunteering
- Background checks, CPR and first aid certification, trauma-informed care training, medication administration training, and mandatory reporter training for all staff

Services

- 24-hour residential support and supervision
- Medication management and administration
- Person-centered support planning and regular review
- Daily living skills instruction
- Care coordination with community providers
- Transportation to appointments and activities
- Meals, nutrition, and dietary accommodation
- Community integration, recreation, and household activity
- Family engagement and care conferences
- Crisis prevention, safety planning, and de-escalation
- Transition and discharge planning
